YCAC (Yadkin Cultural Arts Center) is located in the heart of the Yadkin Valley wine country, less than thirty minutes from Winston-Salem. Since opening in September 2010, the Center has become a gathering place for community residents, artists, tourists, and travelers.

The Center showcases a barnwood-floored, glass-towered exhibition gallery, classrooms, working artists studios and the newly opened Willingham Theatre for performing arts.

The Welborn Gallery is open during Café hours and the Yard Gift Shop and Yard Artists Studios are also available for visiting.

The Third Branch Café, located inside the YCAC, is open Monday through Friday for breakfast and lunch. Dinner with live music is offered on Friday nights, and on Saturday is open from 10 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

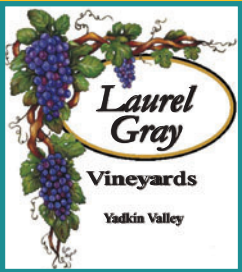

Windsor Run is a family owned vineyard which sits on 13 acres in the Swan Creek AVA of the Yadkin Valley. Originally known as Buck Shoals, it was sold in December of 2011 and reopened in March of 2012 as Windsor Run Cellars with an expanded tasting room. The newly remodeled tasting room can accommodate many tasters in an enjoyable and warm setting. The winery, which is adjacent to the tasting room, has the ability to offer tastings to large groups. The winery also houses a legal moonshine still. From this still Windsor Run currently makes two fortified wines which they sell in the tasting room along with their other wines and meads.
