Daniel Stowe Botanical Garden, a world-class 400-acre facility draws visitors from across the country and features an Orchid Conservatory, a strong addition to the existing 11 gardens, trails and many year-round events.

Featuring one of only 64 basilicas in the US recognized by the Vatican, Belmont Abbey College and Abbey Basilica attract visitors year-long.

Located just across the Catawba River, you'll find the US National Whitewater Center, an outdoor recreation facility for whitewater rafting, canoeing and kayaking.

The Downtown Belmont Historic District, covering 1,700 acres and wonderful examples of Tudor Revival, Bungalow/Craftsman and Colonial Revival architectural styles, has been listed on the National Register of Historic Places since 1996.

### *Unique Shopping, Restaurants And Events*

Stowe Mercantile Co. offers an old-fashioned general store and ice cream fountain that provides unique finds for adults and kids of all ages. A must-see, a trip to the store can be followed by an outing at the Belmont Drive-In, a throwback in time that shows first-run movies. Visit during the summer and you'll always find plenty of festivals, events, concerts in Stowe Park and more. Plus, Belmont offers year-round access to unique shops and boutiques with restaurants and eateries that will keep you fueled for fun.
