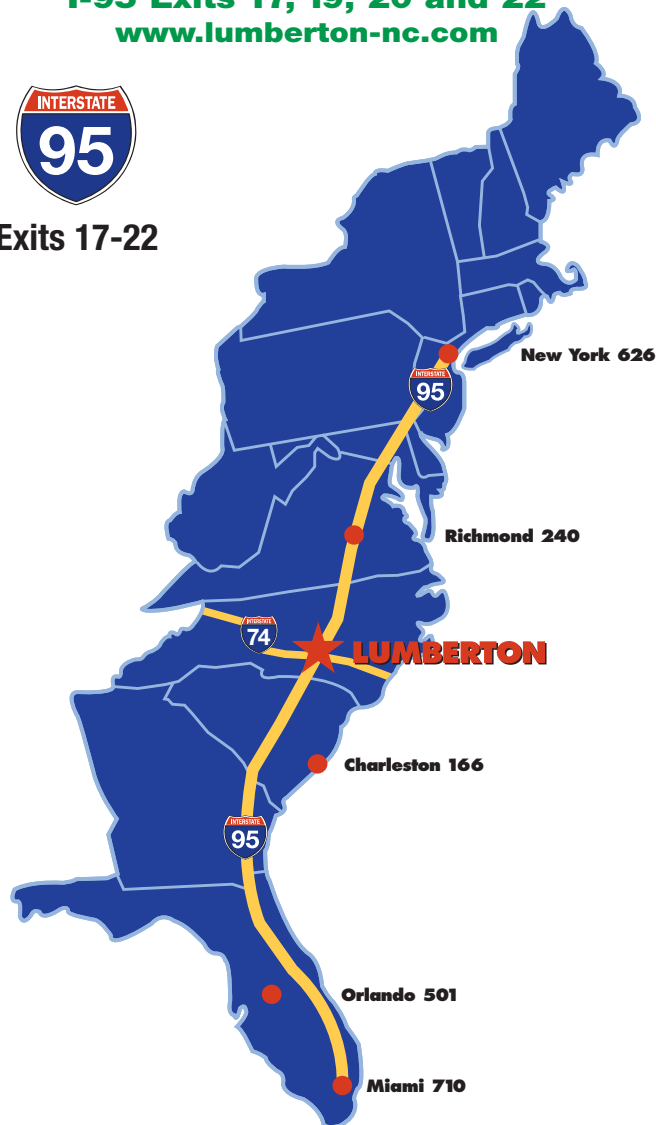

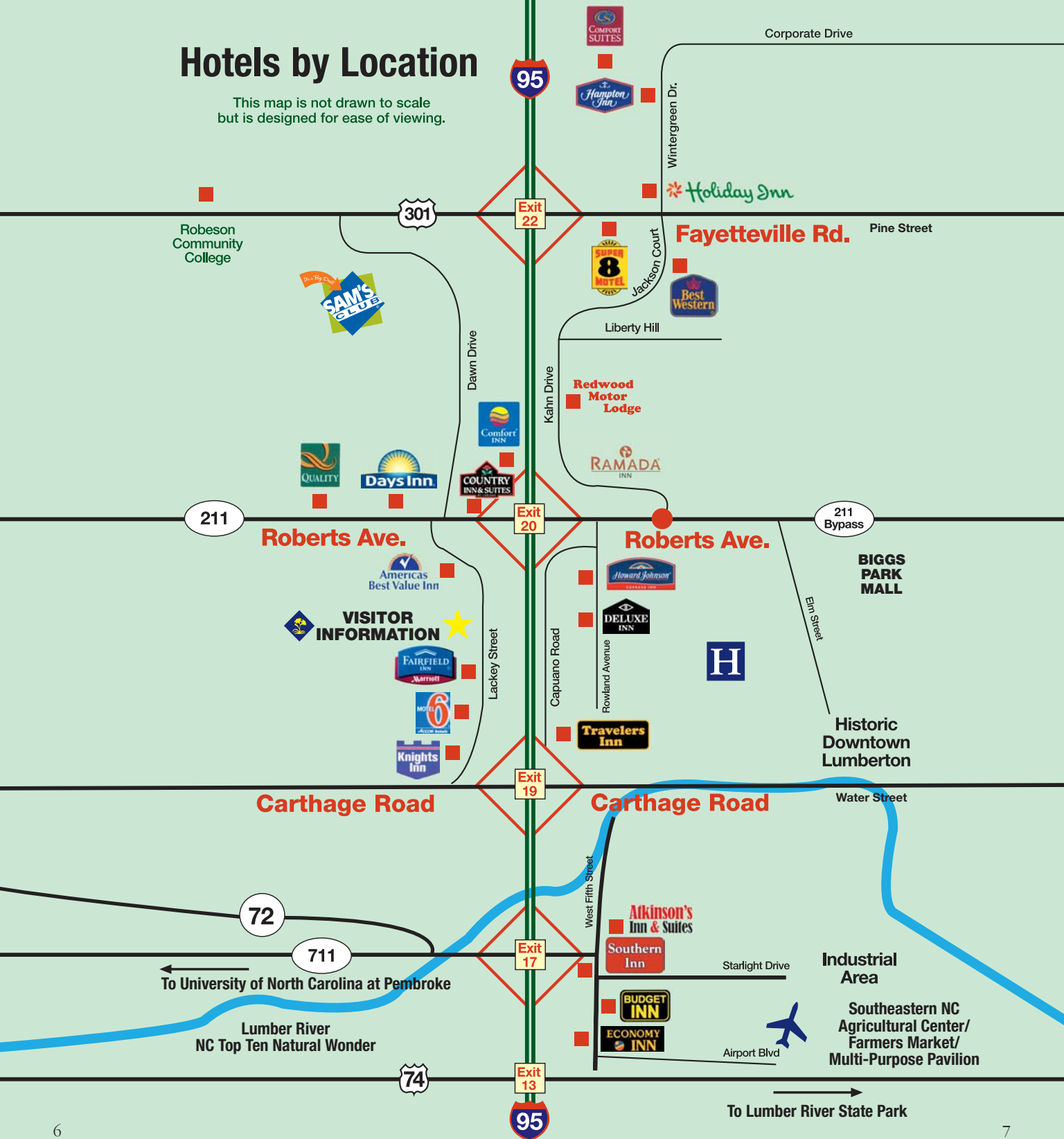

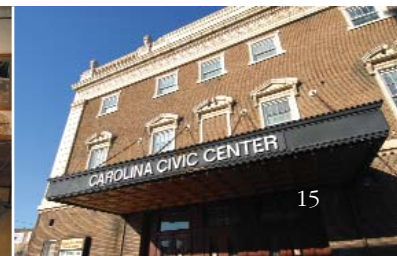

Inside Batting Cages – Rogers Screen Printing and Sports. Hit a bucket of 65-70 balls.

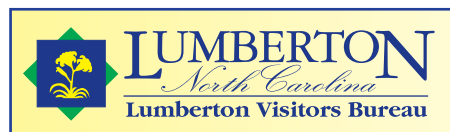
