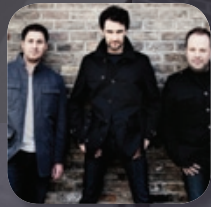

GENERAL INFORMATION

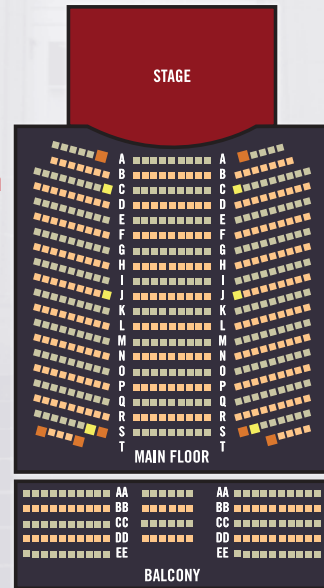
