Set in a quiet historic district just two blocks from downtown, Betsy's B&B is both comfortably homey and romantically Victorian. Three rooms are located in the "pink house," where we live with our two children, a cat and a dog. If you are allergic to pets or prefer a

less homey atmosphere, please request a room in the house next door. There, eight guest rooms are arranged so that each two rooms share access to a central kitchen and living room. They can be rented as individual rooms or as suites. Families and friends

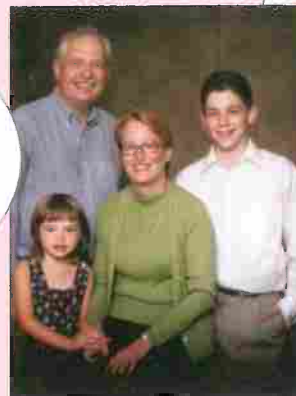
traveling together find the carriage house to be an attractive and economical alternative to separate rooms; this is a two-bedroom apartment over the garage with one double bed, two twin beds, a full kitchen and living/dining room and one bath.

Betsy's B&B offers a delightful retreat for both vacation and business travelers. Guests rave about the comfortable beds and outstanding décor. All rooms are beautifully appointed with quality antiques and oriental rugs. All have air conditioning, cable TV and telephone. The phones have data ports and voice mail for ease in conducting business. We also have a printer, copier, and fax machine on the premises and offer access to the internet from our computer. And yes, we do have private baths. Our most economical room has a bath that is not shared with anyone, but it is down the hall from the room. Each of the other eleven rooms has a private bath en suite.

Breakfast is generous and satisfying. We offer fresh fruit, both homemade and bakery-fresh breads, cereal, juice, coffee (regular and decaf), and tea. Savor eggs prepared to your order or a daily sweet entrée meant to be enjoyed with Vermont maple syrup. We offer bacon or sausage and a nonmeat dish on the side. We are probably the only B&B in Vermont to serve migas, a heavenly scrambling of eggs with green chiles, cheese and tortilla chips. We also serve grits and, in season, fried green tomatoes.

As a "Green Hotel in the Green Mountain State" (recognized by the State of Vermont for exemplary environmental management), we take recycling deliciously seriously. Sample our delectable bread pudding or baked blueberry French toast and you will never again throw out a heel of bread or a day-old muffin.

We are located in the state's largest historic district, with stately homes and office buildings that look much as they did one hundred years ago. Walk 2 1/2 blocks to downtown Montpelier, where you will find the State House, movie theaters, live professional theater, and many fine shops and restaurants.
