Greetings from *Hayodan*! Its *hayppening* again this year, the Mayodan Arts Center is sponsoring the **4th Annual Mayodan Hay Bale Sculpture Festival** – October 1st through November 1st. This year we are expanding to include a 2-day **“What The Hay!”** Street Festival October 13th & 14th, a 5K “Running of the Bales” race on October 21st, and a Bi-Athalon Mountain Bike/Running Race on October 28th. Voting for Best Sculpture will be at the Street Festival.

The Advisory Committee invites you to use your creative design skills to transform hay bales into art of your choosing. This is a fun, creative way open to businesses, associations, non-profits, and anyone who wants to show off their creativity to the community and visitors. There are no design rules except all sculptures and names must be appropriate for all-ages. Humor, especially tongue-in-cheek, is appreciated and encouraged.

GUIDELINES:

- Entry fee is **\$30**; Fee includes one large round bale. Additional bales available for purchase.
- Hay bales will be delivered to each site beginning the third week of September.
- Sculptures should be finished and ready for presentation by October 1st.
- Sculptures may be made out of round or rectangular bales – use your imagination.
- Participants need to provide all materials used on the creation.
- Keep in mind all materials must be secure and withstand the weather conditions.
- If painting, we recommend spray paint.
- An artist from Mayodan Arts Center is available for hire to design your sculpture.
- The Advisory Committee will provide signage that will include the name of the sculpture and name of the participant. Advertising will include social media, print, billboards, and maps/brochures.
- Participants may place the sculpture on private property or on public property. If placed on private property permission of the owner must be secured in writing and presented to the Town before bales are provided. Sculpture locations must not block public streets, alleys or sidewalks or views at intersections. Public property locations are on a “first come, first served basis” and at the discretion of Mayodan Arts Center, whose decision is final for assigning locations on public property.
- All decorative materials must be removed by November 11.
