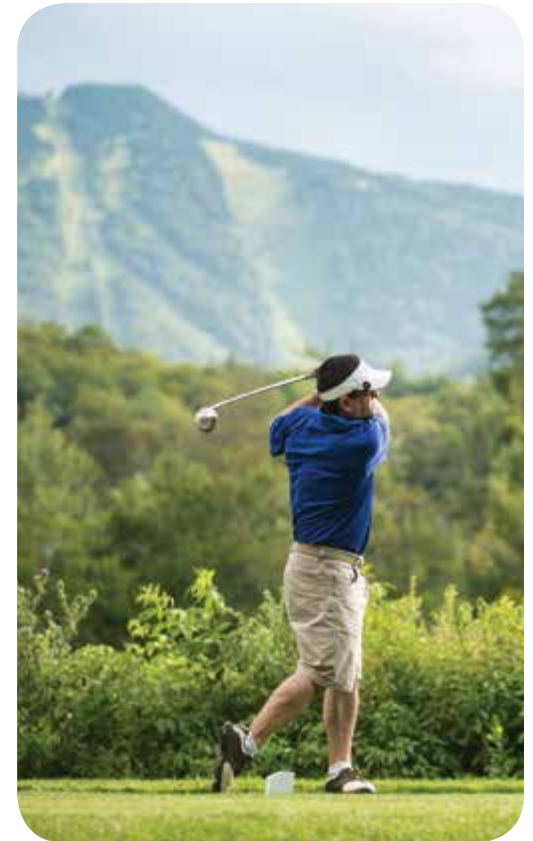
## 4. On the Water

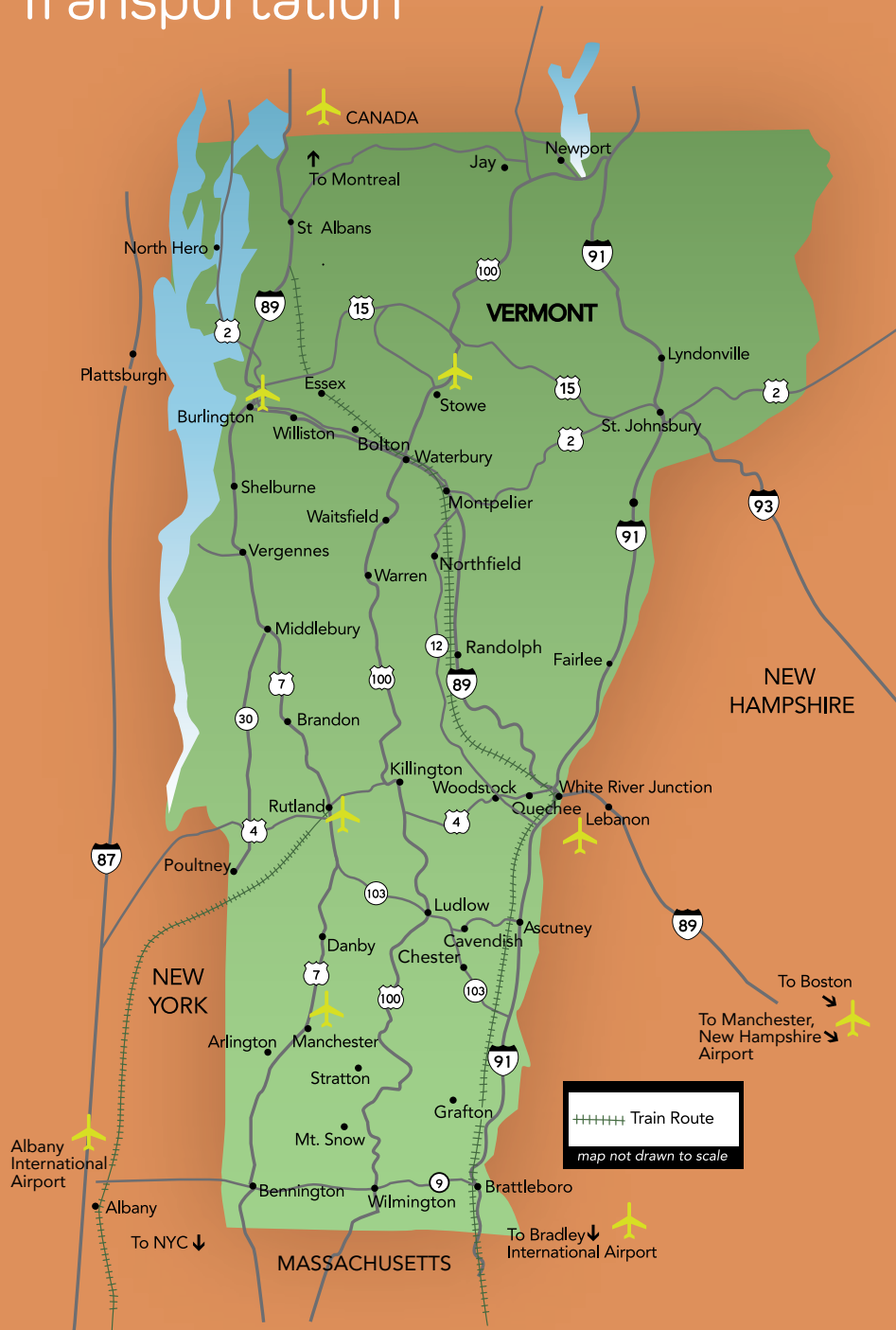


## 5. Farm-to-Table Dining

## Vermont's Champlain Coast Wine Trail

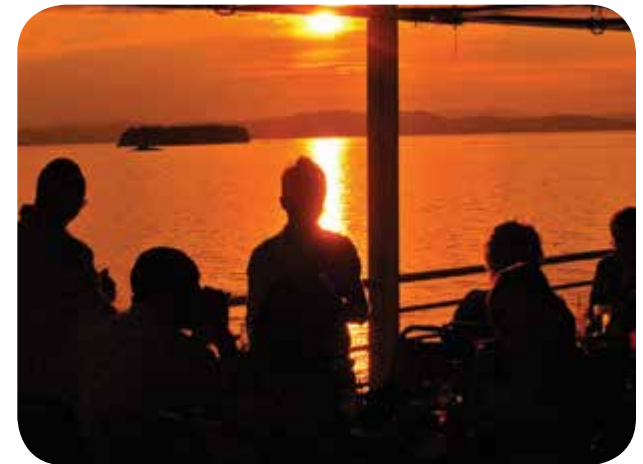
Lake Champlain's deep waters create a microclimate favorable for growing grapes, apples and other fruit popular with vintners. While wines and ciders from this region have won international awards, it's best to taste the terroir yourself! A tour along the Wine Trail allows you to taste an impressive variety of wines, ice wines and ice ciders, within the vineyard or orchard where they are made.

## Shelburne Museum

Explore and discover art, history, and the natural beauty of Vermont at Shelburne Museum, an unconventional and utterly delightful destination in the Champlain Valley. ## Vermont's African American Heritage Trail and Historic Sites

Travel along Vermont's African American Heritage Trail, celebrating the lives and stories of Vermonters whose life's work focused on issues of equality and freedom. The trail takes visitors to Vermont museums and cultural sites where exhibits, films, tours and personal explorations illuminate the lives of African Americans for whom the Green Mountain State was part of their identity. Visitors meet teachers, storytellers, activists, ministers and legislators who bring this important history to life. Vermont also boasts a rich and rewarding historical heritage and that history is well preserved in an exceptional collection of historic sites throughout the state.

## Vermont's Covered Bridges

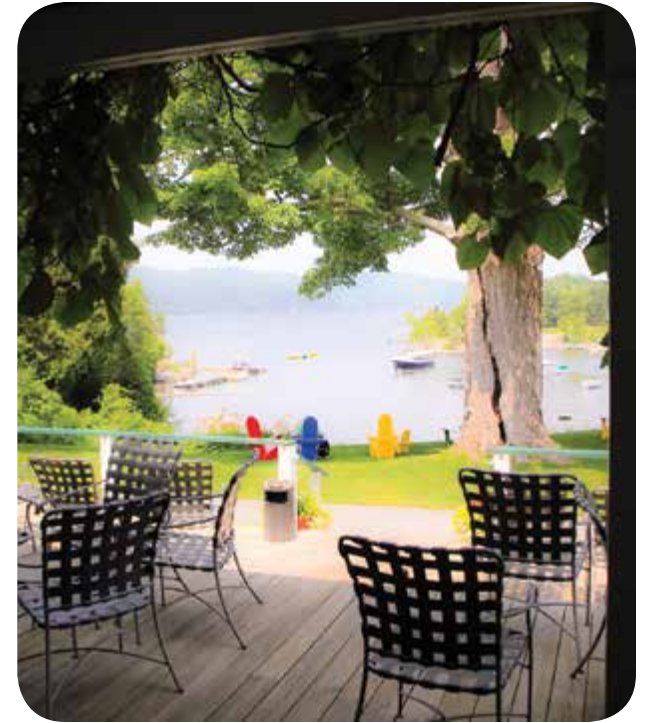

## Farms, Food Stands, & Farmers Markets

There are many local farms to choose from where you can even meet the farmer who grew your food. ## Art and Culture in Vermont
