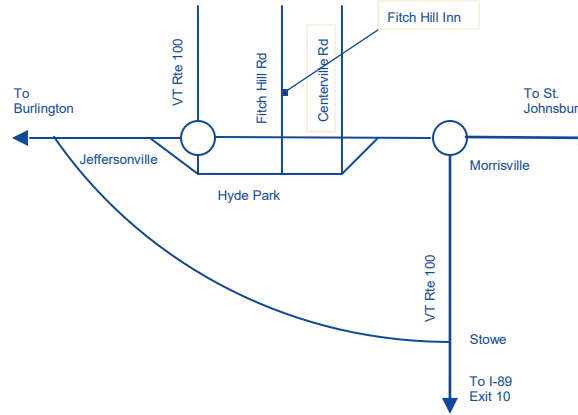


*Winter, Spring, Summer or Fall,

Directions:

Take Exit 10 off Interstate 89
Drive North on VT Rte 100 through Stowe and Morrisville. At the round-about, turn left onto VT Rte 15 West / VT Rte 100 North and drive two miles. Turn right on Fitch Hill Road. The inn is 1/4 mile up the road on the right.

From the West, follow VT Rte 15 East through the round-about in Hyde Park. Turn left at the next road (Fitch Hill Road). The inn is 1/4 mile up the road on the right.

Guestrooms



New Hampshire Suite: A large room with a king bed and a sofa bed, gas fireplace, two-person whirlpool tub & shower, and butlers kitchen. Special touches include a Vermont-made quilt on the bed and a mural of rural Vermont on the wall.



Green Mountain Suite: A large first floor room with a private entrance, a king bed and sofa bed, gas fireplace, two person whirlpool tub & shower and butlers kitchen. Special touches include a Vermont-made quilt on the bed and a panoramic wallpaper border in the bathroom.



Massachusetts Room: Elegant with its embossed rose wallpaper and Vermont-made quilt, this room has a refrigerator and can be set up as two twins or a king bed.

Vermont Federal Room: A sunny south room, formally furnished with a queen canopy bed with a Vermont-made quilt and mountain views.



New York Room: Relaxing with its garden feel, queen sleigh bed and antique furnishings.



Quebec Country Room: Bright and cheerful with its blue and white décor, a queen bed with a Vermont-made quilt and lovely mountain views.



All the rooms have private, in-room baths, individual heat control in winter and air conditioning in summer. The inn has a guest computer and Wi-Fi. Amenities include robes, irons and boards and hair dryers.
