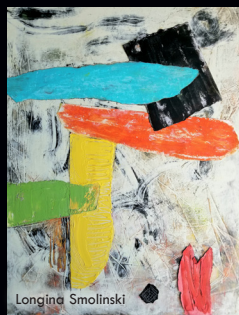

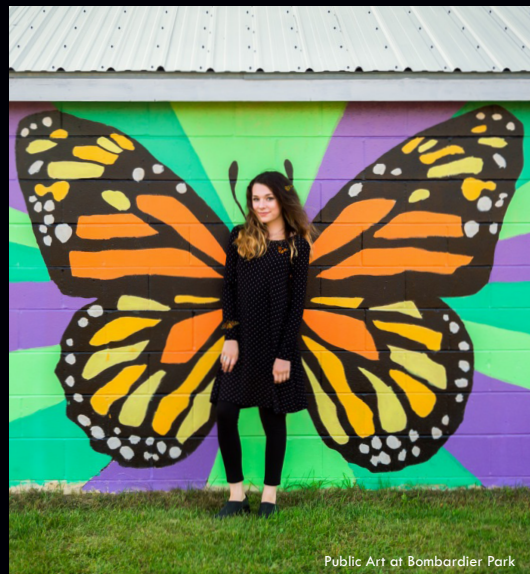


About the Guild

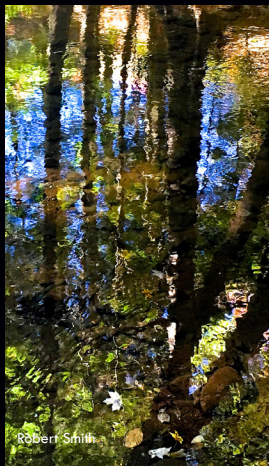
The Milton Artists' Guild (MAG) was formed in 1988 and received its non-profit status in 2011.

The growing membership of the Milton Artists' Guild reflects the diverse base of creative talent throughout Vermont and beyond. Monthly meetings of the MAG provide opportunities for members to share ideas and resources for the promotion of creative expression, to gain confidence in their work and to find solutions to artistic challenges while building business skills. The MAG meets on the third Thursday of every month except December.

Our ambition is to focus on promoting public outdoor art in Milton. ART is for everyone. Community art instills a sense of pride and belonging. Timeless projects accomplished include the MAGnificent mural at the Gardener's Supply Distribution Center, the Art Park at Milton Square, the Bombardier Park Dugout Murals, and more. 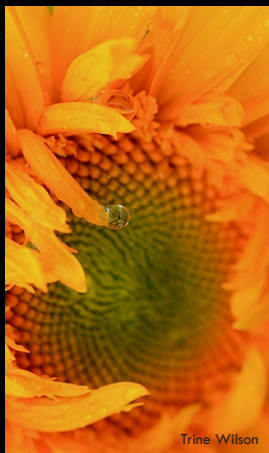
Public Art at Bombardier Park
